

## CREDIT REQUIREMENTS FOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION

Students must attain the minimum number of credits determined by Manitoba Education and Advanced Learning to be eligible for high school graduation.

It is the responsibility of the school administration to determine that students planning to graduate in June of a given year are enrolled in the required number of courses to achieve graduation. This determination shall be made during the fall term preceding the anticipated graduation.

School diplomas must be offered in accordance with Manitoba high school graduation requirements, as is the case with provincial diplomas. Schools are, however, encouraged to recognize the attainment of credit levels beyond the required minimum established by Manitoba Education and Advanced Learning.

High school credits previously earned outside of Manitoba will be considered for inclusion as part of meeting Manitoba high school graduation requirements. The inclusion of credits earned out of province will be in accordance with Manitoba Education and Advanced Learning, at the discretion of the school principal, and with the consultation with the Superintendent as necessary.
