

OUT-OF-PROVINCE STUDENTS

1. Out-of-Province students may attend schools within the Division with Board approval as provided in the Public Schools Act.
2. Prior to the Board acceptance of out-of-province students into the Division, proof of guardianship for students under the age of 18 must be provided by the legal adult with whom the student will be residing.
3. The transfer fee as determined by the Province under Schools of Choice legislation will apply. This fee may be waived at the discretion of the Board.
4. High school credits previously earned outside of Manitoba will be considered for inclusion as part of meeting Manitoba high school graduation requirements, as per Manitoba Education and Advanced Learning requirements, at the discretion of the school Principal, and in consultation as necessary with the Superintendent.
